

**(1) Privacy Notice pursuant to art. 13, Legislative Decree 196/2003**

**Collection of data** by Explora 360 s.r.l.s. with registered office in Olbia, Viale Aldo Moro no. 288 - as the Data Controller, informs you that the personal data collected by filling out the form will be processed in order to provide assistance on reservations and / or to respond to requests for information about the facilities, in relation to the website [www .explora360.it](http://www.explora360.it)

Explora 360 s.r.l.s. Does not collect any "sensitive" data (health status, religion, etc.), nor does it communicate to third parties or disseminate them. The required data are Title or company name / First and Last Name, City, Email Address, Telephone Number. Users are encouraged not to include sensitive personal information such as, for example, information on race or ethnicity, political trends, religious and philosophical beliefs, participation in trade union organizations and Politics, physical and mental illness, sexual preferences, crimes or legal proceedings affecting them. Users who, despite this notice, enter sensitive personal information thereby authorize the holder of the data and anyone with legitimate access to the data to use it for the above-mentioned purposes.

The acquired data will be processed electronically and manually by means of procedures to ensure compliance with the relevant regulatory provisions. Specific security measures are taken to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access to the data. Personal data entered by users will remain in the database until the person concerned withdraws consent to the communications for which consent has been given by following the instructions below.

**Method and means of consent**

For the aforementioned purposes, consent is required for the processing of your personal data, by using the check mark in the registration form.

You are free to provide your personal data in the application forms. Failure to do so or the failure to show consent to the collection in the manner indicated above may only result in the inability to obtain the requested free services.

**Categories of persons to whom personal data may be disclosed or who may become aware of them as managers or employees.**

The personal data will be handled by the staff (employees, support staff, etc.) who have been designated "Data Controller" and have received the relevant operating instructions regarding the data and operate under the direct authority of the " Data Controller Manager" when appointed.

In addition to the aforesaid persons, some personal data processing of the person concerned may also be carried out by third parties, based in Italy and / or abroad (within the limits permitted by law), to which the Owner entrusts certain activities of a technical, organizational or management nature (or part of them) that are functional to the provision of free services cited for sending commercial communications. In that case, the same persons will act as external managers of the data collection and handling. The data controllers will receive appropriate operating instructions, with particular reference to the adoption of minimum security measures, in order to guarantee the confidentiality and security of the data.

**Rights of the interested parties**

According to art. 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003, you have the following rights: "Art. 7. Right of access to personal data and other rights "

1. The person concerned has the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or otherwise of personal data concerning him, even if not yet registered, and their communication in an intelligible form.
  
1. The person concerned has the right to obtain indication of:
  1. the origin of personal data;
  2. the purposes and methods of handling;
  3. of the logic applied in the processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;
  4. the identification details of the data controller, of the persons responsible;
  5. the persons or categories of persons to whom personal data may be disclosed or who may

become aware of it as designated representative in the territory of the State, of persons in charge.

3. The person concerned has the right to obtain:

1. updating, rectification or, where relevant, integration of data;
2. Cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of law, including those that are not required to be kept in relation to the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed;
3. the attestation that the operations referred to in points (a) and (b) have been made aware, including their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except where such fulfilment are impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right.

4. The person concerned has the right to oppose, in whole or in part:

1. for legitimate reasons for the processing of personal data concerning him, even though relevant to the purpose of the collection;
2. to the processing of personal data concerning him for the purpose of sending advertising material or direct sales or for conducting market research or commercial communication.
